- 9 by order may establish reasonable fines to be collected by a county
- 10 library for lost, damaged, or overdue library property.
- 11 (b) The fines shall be deposited in the county free library
- 12 fund.
- 13 Sec. 323.072. ABUSE OF COUNTY LIBRARY SERVICES. (a) The
- 14 commissioners court by order may adopt reasonable regulations that
- 15 prohibit a person from abusing library services by intentionally
- 16 failing to pay a library fine or return library property.
- 17 (b) A person who violates a regulation adopted by the county
- 18 under this section is liable to the county for a civil penalty of
- 19 not more than \$100 for each violation. A county may bring suit in a
- 20 district or county court to recover a civil penalty authorized by
- 21 this subsection.
