## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED 1 AN ACT 2 relating to alternative dispute resolution of certain insurance payment disputes with chiropractors. 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS: 4 5 SECTION 1. Subchapter D, Chapter 1952, Insurance Code, is amended by adding Section 1952.1561 to read as follows: 6 Sec. 1952.1561. PAYMENT DISPUTES RELATING TO CHIROPRACTIC 7 CARE. (a) An insurer may not bring an action related to a payment 8 9 required under Section 1952.156 made for chiropractic care unless not later than one year after the date of service the chiropractor 10 and the insurer have submitted the dispute to an alternative 11 dispute resolution process and failed to resolve the dispute. 12 (b) The statute of limitations applicable to a cause of 13 14 action arising out of the dispute is tolled beginning on the date the dispute arises and ending on the date the alternative dispute 15 16 resolution process is completed. SECTION 2. This Act applies only to an insurance policy that 17 is delivered, issued for delivery, or renewed on or after January 1, 18 2014. A policy delivered, issued for delivery, or renewed before 19

January 1, 2014, is governed by the law as it existed immediately before the effective date of this Act, and that law is continued in effect for that purpose.

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SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2013.

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
