- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Subchapter D, Chapter 32, Election Code, is
- 6 amended by adding Section 32.076 to read as follows:
- 7 Sec. 32.076. REMOVAL OF WATCHER OR CLERK FROM POLLING
- 8 PLACE. A presiding judge may not remove a watcher or election clerk
- 9 from a polling place unless:

- 10 (1) the early voting clerk approves the removal; or
- 11 (2) the removal is pursuant to an arrest warrant
- 12 <u>issued by the presiding judge under Section 32.075(c).</u>
- SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 14 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 15 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 16 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 17 Act takes effect September 1, 2013.
