## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT

- 2 relating to the use of a credit or charge card by a state agency to
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Section 403.023, Government Code, is amended by
- 6 adding Subsection (b-1) to read as follows:
- 7 (b-1) If the comptroller adopts rules authorized under
- 8 Subsection (b), the rules must:

make certain purchases.

- 9 <u>(1) require the state agency to use a credit or charge</u>
- 10 card to pay for all purchases unless the comptroller determines
- 11 that another method of payment will result in greater cost savings
- 12 to the state; and
- (2) prohibit an employee of the state agency from
- 14 using a personal credit or charge card to pay for the state agency's
- 15 purchases.

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- SECTION 2. Subchapter B, Chapter 2171, Government Code, is
- 17 amended by adding Section 2171.0521 to read as follows:
- 18 Sec. 2171.0521. PAYMENT FOR TRAVEL SERVICES WITH CREDIT OR
- 19 CHARGE CARD. If a state agency participates in a program
- 20 administered by the comptroller that allows the agency to use a
- 21 credit or charge card to purchase travel services:
- 22 (1) the agency shall use the credit or charge card to
- 23 purchase travel services required for agency travel, unless the
- 24 comptroller determines that another method of purchase will result

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- 1 <u>in greater cost savings to the state; and</u>
- 2 (2) an employee of the agency may not use the
- 3 employee's personal credit or charge card to purchase travel
- 4 services required for agency travel.
- 5 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 6 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 7 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 8 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 9 Act takes effect September 1, 2013.
