- 9 duty that is classified as a wildland fire-fighting duty, including
- 10 conducting a prescribed burn, unless the person is a permanent,
- 11 full-time fire department employee regularly assigned to perform
- one or more duties listed under Section 419.021(3)(C), regardless
- 13 of whether the person holds a certificate issued by the commission

- 15 SECTION 2. Section 419.909, Government Code, is amended by
