## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

- 1 AN ACT
- 2 relating to parental involvement in certain procedures regarding a
- 3 school campus receiving an unacceptable performance rating under
- 4 certain circumstances.
- 5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- SECTION 1. Sections 39.107(a), (e), and (e-2), are amended
- 7 to read as follows:
- 8 (a) Except as provided by Subsection (e-2), after [After] a
- 9 campus has been identified as unacceptable for two consecutive
- 10 school years, the commissioner shall order the reconstitution of
- 11 the campus.
- 12 (e) If a campus is considered to have an unacceptable
- 13 performance rating for two [three] consecutive school years after
- 14 the campus is reconstituted under Subsection (a), the commissioner,
- 15 subject to Subsection (e-1) or (e-2), shall order:
- 16 (1) repurposing of the campus under this section;
- 17 (2) alternative management of the campus under this
- 18 section; or
- 19 (3) closure of the campus.
- 20 (e-2) For purposes of this subsection, "parent" has the
- 21 meaning assigned by Section 12.051. If the commissioner is
- 22 presented, in the time and manner specified by commissioner rule, a
- 23 written petition signed by the parents of a majority of the students
- 24 enrolled at a campus to which Subsection (a) or (e) applies,

- 1 specifying  $\underline{an}$  [the] action described by Subsection (e)(1), (2), or
- 2 (3) that the parents request the commissioner to order, the
- 3 commissioner shall [ $\tau$  except as otherwise authorized by this
- 4 subsection, order the specific action requested. The commissioner
- 5 shall adopt rules defining the role of parents in the
- 6 implementation of the requested action, including selection of an
- 7 alternative management provider or entity engaged for repurposing,
- 8 as applicable [If the board of trustees of the school district in
- 9 which the campus is located presents to the commissioner, in the
- 10 time and manner specified by commissioner rule, a written request
- 11 that the commissioner order specific action authorized under
- 12 Subsection (c) other than the specific action requested in the
- 13 parents' petition and a written explanation of the basis for the
- 14 board's request, the commissioner may order the action requested by
- 15 the board of trustees].
- 16 SECTION 2. The changes in law made by this Act apply
- 17 beginning with the 2013-2014 school year.
- SECTION 3. The changes in law made by this Act supersede any
- 19 other law to the extent of a conflict.
- 20 SECTION 4. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 21 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 22 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 23 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 24 Act takes effect September 1, 2013.
