1-19 relating to lobbying expenditures that are made jointly.
1-20 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
1-21 SECTION 1. Section 305.0021(b), Government Code, is amended
1-22 to read as follows:
1-23 (b) For purposes of Section 36.02 or 36.10, Penal Code, a
1-24 person described by Subsection (a)(2)(A) is not considered to have
1-25 made an expenditure [the amount of a joint expenditure that is
1-26 attributed to a person who is not a registrant is not an expenditure
1-27 made and reported] in accordance with this chapter.
1-28 SECTION 2. The amendment made by this Act to Section
1-29 305.0021(b), Government Code, is intended to clarify rather than
1-30 change existing law.
1-31 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2013.
