- 5 SECTION 1. Section 38.12, Penal Code, is amended by adding
- 6 Subsection (d-1) and amending Subsections (g) and (h) to read as
- 7 follows:
- 8 (d-1) A person commits an offense if:
- 9 (1) the person, with the intent to obtain professional
- 10 employment for the person or another person, solicits or causes to
- 11 be solicited, in person or by telephone, employment that relates to
- 12 the provision of legal services involving the solicited person; and
- 13 (2) the person obtained the information used to make
- 14 the solicitation described by Subdivision (1) from personal
- 15 information contained in a citation for a violation of Subtitle C,
- 16 Title 7, Transportation code, issued to the solicited person.
- 17 (g) Except as provided by Subsection (h), an offense under
- 18 Subsection (d) or (d-1) is a Class A misdemeanor.
- (h) An offense under Subsection (d) or (d-1) is a felony of
- 20 the third degree if it is shown on the trial of the offense that the
- 21 defendant has previously been convicted under either Subsection (d)
- 22 or (d-1).
- SECTION 2. Section 38.12(d-1), Penal Code, as added by this
- 24 Act, applies only to an offense committed on or after the effective

- 1 date of this Act. An offense committed before the effective date of
- $2\,$  this Act is covered by the law in effect when the offense was
- 3 committed, and that law is continued in effect for that purpose.
- 4 For purposes of this section, an offense is committed before the
- 5 effective date of this Act if any element of the offense occurs
- 6 before that date.
- 7 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2013.
