A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

- 2 relating to the use of the skills development fund to support
- 3 certain joint credit courses offered by school districts under
- 4 agreements with public junior colleges.
- 5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 6 SECTION 1. Section 303.003, Labor Code, is amended by
- 7 adding Subsection (b-1) to read as follows:
- 8 (b-1) In addition to the purposes described by Subsection
- 9 (b), money from the skills development fund may be awarded to a
- 10 public junior college to be used under an agreement with a school
- 11 district to support courses offered for joint high school and
- 12 public junior college credit or offered under a college credit
- 13 career or technical education program that leads to an
- 14 industry-recognized license, credential, or certificate.
- 15 Appropriate uses of money awarded under this subsection include
- 16 purchasing or repairing necessary equipment for a course and
- 17 developing a course curriculum. A course or program supported
- 18 under this subsection must have the endorsement of, or a letter of
- 19 support from, at least one employer in this state.
- 20 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 21 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 22 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 23 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 24 Act takes effect September 1, 2013.
