A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT

1-19 relating to the use of the skills development fund and other funds 1-20 available to the Texas Workforce Commission to support certain 1-21 1-22 joint credit courses offered by school districts under agreements with lower-division institutions of higher education. 1-23

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

1-24 SECTION 1. Section 303.003, Labor Code, is amended by 1-25 adding Subsections (b-2) and (i) to read as follows:

(b-2) In addition to the purposes described by Subsections (b) and (b-1), in each state fiscal biennium, an amount of money from the skills development fund not to exceed five percent of the 1-26 1-27 1-28 1-29 amount of general revenue appropriated to the skills development 1-30 fund for that biennium may be used as provided by this subsection. Funds available to the commission from other sources may also be used as provided by this subsection. Funds may be awarded under 1-31 1-32 this subsection to a lower-division institution of higher education 1-33 1-34 to be used under an agreement with a school district to support 1-35 courses offered for joint high school and college-level credit or offered under a college credit career or technical education program that leads to an industry-recognized license, credential, 1-36 1-37 or certificate. Appropriate uses of funds awarded under this 1-38 1-39 subsection include purchasing or repairing necessary equipment for 1-40 a course and developing a course curriculum. A course or program supported under this subsection must: (1) have the endorsement 1-41
