7	Sec. 59.401. DEFINITIONS. In this subchapter:
8	(1) "Cardholder" means the person named on the face of
9	a debit or stored value card to whom or for whose benefit the card is
10	issued.
11	(2) "Debit card" has the meaning in Section 502.001,
12	Business & Commerce Code.
13	(3) "Goods" means tangible, readily portable items
14	offered for sale.
15	(4) "Merchant" means a person in the business of
16	selling or leasing goods or services.
17	(5) "Services" means work, labor, or service that is
18	purchased, including services furnished in connection with the sale
19	or repair of goods or with the rental of goods.
20	(6) "Stored value card" has the meaning as defined in
21	Section 604.001(1), Business & Commerce Code, but does not include
22	the meaning as defined in Section 604.001(2), Business & Commerce
23	Code.

Sec. 59.402. IMPOSITION OF SURCHARGE FOR USE OF DEBIT OR

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- 1 STORED VALUE CARD. (a) In a sale of goods or services, a merchant
- 2 may not impose a surcharge on a buyer who uses a debit or stored
- 3 value card instead of cash, a check, credit card, or a similar means
- 4 of payment.
- 5 (b) This section does not apply to a state agency, county,
- 6 <u>local governmental entity</u>, or other governmental entity that
- 7 accepts a debit or stored value card for the payment of fees, taxes,
- 8 or other charges.
- 9 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2013.
