- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Section 814.102, Government Code, is amended to
- 6 read as follows:
- 7 Sec. 814.102. <u>LIMITED</u> ELIGIBILITY OF ELECTED MEMBERS FOR
- 8 SERVICE RETIREMENT. (a) Except as provided by rule adopted under
- 9 Section 813.304(d) or Section 803.202(a)(2), a member who has
- 10 service credit in the elected class of membership <u>for service</u>
- 11 performed before September 1, 2013, is eligible to retire and
- 12 receive a service retirement annuity if the member:
- 13 (1) is at least 60 years old and has 8 years of service
- 14 credit in that class; or
- 15 (2) is at least 50 years old and has 12 years of
- 16 service credit in that class.
- 17 (b) A person who first becomes eligible to be a member of the
- 18 <u>legislature on or after September 1, 2013, is not eligible to</u>
- 19 receive an elected class service retirement annuity.
- 20 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2013.
