The petition must: (1) be signed by at least 50 registered voters of the district as determined by the most recent official list of registered voters; (2) be filed not later than 5 p.m. on the <u>same</u> [62nd] day that an application for a place on the ballot must be filed <u>under Section 144.005</u> , Election Code [before the date of the election]; and (3) specify the <u>single-member district</u> [commissioners precinct] the candidate wants to represent [or specify that the candidate wants to represent the district at large].
