- 2 relating to the powers and duties of the Legislative Budget Board,
- 3 including the receipt of reports by the board.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Section 2054.102, Government Code, is amended by
- 6 amending Subsection (a) and adding Subsections (a-1) and (a-2) to
- 7 read as follows:
- 8 (a) The Legislative Budget Board may specify procedures for
- 9 the submission, review, approval, and disapproval of biennial
- 10 operating plans and amendments, including procedures for review or
- 11 reconsideration of the Legislative Budget Board's disapproval of a
- 12 biennial operating plan or biennial operating plan amendment.
- 13 <u>(a-1)</u> The Legislative Budget Board shall review and approve
- 14 or disapprove the biennial operating plan or biennial operating
- 15 plan amendment not later than the 60th day after the later of the:
- 16 (1) date of adjournment sine die of a regular
- 17 legislative session by the second house of the legislature to
- 18 <u>adjourn sine die; or</u>
- 19 <u>(2)</u> date the plan or amendment to the plan is
- 20 submitted.
- 21 (a-2) The plan or amendment to the plan is considered to be
- 22 approved on the 61st day after the <u>later of the dates described by</u>
- 23 Subsection (a-1) [date the plan or amendment is submitted] if the
- 24 Legislative Budget Board does not disapprove the plan or amendment

- 1 before that date.
- 2 SECTION 2. Section 19.0041, Education Code, is amended to
- 3 read as follows:
- 4 Sec. 19.0041. EVALUATION OF TRAINING SERVICES. (a) To
- 5 evaluate the effectiveness of training services provided to persons
- 6 confined or imprisoned in the department, the Windham School
- 7 District shall [consult with the Legislative Budget Board to]
- 8 compile and analyze information for each person who receives the
- 9 training services. This information shall include an evaluation
- 10 of:
- 11 (1) the kind of training services provided;
- 12 (2) the kind of employment the person obtains on
- 13 release;
- 14 (3) whether the employment was related to training;
- 15 (4) the difference between the amount of the person's
- 16 earnings on the date employment is obtained following release and
- 17 the amount of those earnings on the first anniversary of that date;
- 18 and
- 19 (5) the retention factors associated with the
- 20 employment.
- 21 (b) The <u>district</u> [<u>Legislative Budget Board</u>] shall submit an
- 22 annual report to the [legislature and the] governor's office and
- 23 the Legislative Budget Board based on data compiled and analyzed
- 24 under Subsection (a).
- 25 SECTION 3. Not later than December 1, 2013, the Windham
- 26 School District shall submit the first report to the governor's
- 27 office and the Legislative Budget Board as required by Section

- 1 19.0041(b), Education Code, as amended by this Act.
- 2 SECTION 4. Section 322.016(b), Government Code, is
- 3 repealed.
- 4 SECTION 5. The changes in law made by this Act apply to a
- 5 biennial operating plan or biennial operating plan amendment
- 6 submitted to or pending with the Legislative Budget Board on or
- 7 after the effective date of this Act.
- 8 SECTION 6. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 9 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 10 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 11 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 12 Act takes effect September 1, 2013.
