Section 623.219(a), Transportation Code, 5 is amended to read as follows: 6 (a) For a permit issued by a port authority located in a 7 county that borders the United Mexican States, the commission 8 shall, with the consent of the port authority, designate the most 9 direct route from: 10 11 (1) the Gateway International Bridge or the Veterans 12 International Bridge at Los Tomates to the entrance of the Port of Brownsville using State Highways 48 and 4 or United States Highways 13 14 77 and 83 or using United States Highway 77 and United States Highway 83, East Loop Corridor, and State Highway 4; and 15 16 (2) the Free Trade International Bridge to the entrance of the Port of Brownsville using Farm-to-Market Road 509, 17 United States Highways 77 and 83, Farm-to-Market Road 511, State 18 Highway 550, and East Loop (State Highway 32). 19 20 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2013.
