| 12 | (B) a fee is charged for the privilege of |

| 16 | (19) "Gun show promoter" means a person who organizes, |
| 17 | plans, promotes, or operates a gun show. |

- 20 Sec. 46.065. CERTAIN REQUIREMENTS RELATING TO SALES AT GUN
- 21 SHOWS. (a) A person commits an offense if the person knowingly
- 22 sells a firearm to another person in exchange for money or other
- 23 consideration at a gun show without complying with the national
- 24 instant criminal background check system in the manner required by

- 1 18 U.S.C. Section 922 before completing the sale. A person who
- 2 conducts a criminal background check as required by this subsection
- 3 may charge a fee in an amount equal to the cost incurred by the
- 4 person to obtain the background check.
- 5 (b) A person commits an offense if the person knowingly

- 7 consideration at a gun show and the person does not maintain a
- 8 record of the sale.
- 9 (c) It is an exception to the application of Subsection (a)
- 10 that the person to whom the firearm is sold is:

- 16 Sec. 46.066. CERTAIN REQUIREMENTS RELATING TO GUN SHOW
- 17 PROMOTER. (a) A gun show promoter commits an offense if the
- 18 promoter, with criminal negligence, permits the sale of a firearm
- 19 to a person at a gun show organized, planned, promoted, or operated
- 20 by the promoter without complying with the national instant
- 21 criminal background check system in the manner required by 18
- 22 U.S.C. Section 922 before completion of the sale.
- 23 (b) It is an exception to the application of Subsection (a)
- 24 that the person to whom the firearm is sold is:
- 25 (1) a peace officer; or
- 26 (2) a person who is licensed to carry a concealed
- 27 handgun under Subchapter H, Chapter 411, Government Code.

- 1 (c) Not later than the 30th day before the date on which a

- 8 to conduct, an instant criminal background check in the manner

- 10 firearm at a gun show organized, planned, promoted, or operated by
- 11 the promoter from another person who is not a licensed firearms
- 12 dealer under 18 U.S.C. Section 923. A person who conducts a
- 13 criminal background check as required by this subsection may charge
- 14 <u>a fee in an amount equal to the cost incurred by the person to obtain</u>
- 15 the background check.
- (e) A gun show promoter shall prominently post a notice in a
- 17 form prescribed by the Department of Public Safety stating the
- 18 requirements under this section and Section 46.065 relating to an
- 19 instant criminal background check.
- 20 (f) A gun show promoter commits an offense if the promoter
- 21 violates Subsection (c), (d), or (e).
- 22 (g) An offense under Subsection (a) or (f) is a Class A
- 23 <u>misdemeanor</u>.
- 24 (h) If conduct constituting an offense under this section
- 25 also constitutes an offense under Section 46.065, the actor may be
- 26 prosecuted under either section or under both sections.
- SECTION 3. The change in law made by Section 46.066(c),

- 1 Penal Code, as added by this Act, applies only to a gun show held on
- 2 or after October 1, 2013.
- 3 SECTION 4. This Act takes effect September 1, 2013.
