- 2 relating to eligibility to file for compensation by persons
- 3 wrongfully imprisoned.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Section 103.003, Civil Practice and Remedies
- 6 Code, is repealed.
- 7 SECTION 2. Section 103.054, Civil Practice and Remedies
- 8 Code, is amended to read as follows:
- 9 Sec. 103.054. PAYMENT OF CERTAIN TUITION AND FEES. If
- 10 requested by the claimant before the seventh anniversary of the
- 11 date the claimant received the pardon or was granted relief as
- 12 required by Section 103.001 [relevant date described by Section
- 13 103.003], tuition for up to 120 credit hours, including tuition
- 14 charged under Section 54.0513, Education Code, or any other law
- 15 granting an educational institution discretion to set the tuition
- 16 rate, and any mandatory fees associated with attendance at the
- 17 institution, charged by a career center or public institution of
- 18 higher education shall be paid on behalf of the claimant.
- 19 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 20 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 21 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 22 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 23 Act takes effect September 1, 2013.
