BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

SECTION 1. Section 22.012, Parks and Wildlife Code, amended to read as follows:

Sec. 22.012. SAN JACINTO HISTORICAL ADVISORY BOARD. The San Jacinto Historical Advisory Board is composed of:

- (1)the chairman of the Battleship Texas Foundation [Commission];
- (2) the president of the San Jacinto Museum of History Association; and
- (3) three members of the public.

 (b) The three members of the public are appointed by the governor for terms of six years each, with the term of one member 1-31 1-32 1-33 expiring each odd-numbered year. 1-34
 - (c) One or more of the three members of the public may be selected from the San Jacinto Chapter, Daughters of the Republic of
 - SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2013.
