3	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
4	SECTION 1. Chapter 341, Local Government Code, is amended
5	by adding Section 341.906 to read as follows:
6	Sec. 341.906. NOTIFICATION OF PHOTOGRAPHIC MONITORING
7	SYSTEM. (a) In this section:
8	(1) "Photographic monitoring system" means a system
9	that:
10	(A) consists of a camera or cameras installed in
11	an outdoor public area; and
12	(B) is active and capable of producing one or
13	more recorded images.
14	(2) "Recorded image" means an image that is recorded
15	on a photograph or digital image.
16	(b) This section applies only to a municipality that employs
17	an active photographic monitoring system.
18	(c)(1) A municipality shall install signs adjacent to or
19	within 10 feet of each camera which is a part of a photographic
20	monitoring system. The signs must be easily readable and clearly
21	indicate the presence of a photographic monitoring system.
22	(2) The sign shall contain the words:
23	"Warning: You are under Surveillance by the City
24	of [name of municipality]."

- 1 (d) A municipality that fails to comply with Subsection (c)
- 2 may not use any images captured by a photographic monitoring system
- 3 in the investigation or prosecution of any individual.
- 4 (e) Any recorded image captured by a municipal camera which
- 5 fails to comply with Subsection (c) of this section shall not be
- 6 used in any investigation or prosecution by any political
- 7 <u>subdivision</u>.
- 8 <u>(f)</u> A live video feed composed of the same images captured
- 9 by a camera which is a part of a photographic monitoring system must
- 10 be published and otherwise made available in real time on the
- 11 internet and must be made accessible through the municipality's
- 12 website.
- 13 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect January 1, 2014.
