5	SECTION 1. Subchapter D, Chapter 39, Utilities Code, is
6	amended by adding Section 39.1571 to read as follows:

- 7 Sec. 39.1571. COMMISSION AUTHORITY DURING EXTREME
- 8 CONGESTION EVENT. The commission by rule shall establish:
- 9 <u>(1)</u> a method to implement a temporary shadow price cap
- 10 of \$500 per megawatt to prevent retail customers from absorbing
- 11 unusually high congestion charges during an extreme congestion
- 12 event;
- (2) criteria to define an "extreme congestion event";
- 14 and
- 15 (3) a method to determine what unusually high
- 16 congestion charges are.
- 17 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2013.
