- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 4 SECTION 1. Sec. 418.114, Government Code, is repealed.
- 5 SECTION 2. Sec. 418.115, Government Code, is amended as
- 6 follows:
- 7 Sec. 418.115. REQUESTING AND PROVIDING MUTUAL AID
- 8 ASSISTANCE. (a) A request for mutual aid assistance may be
- 9 submitted verbally or in writing. If a request is submitted
- 10 verbally, it must be confirmed in writing not later than the 30th
- 11 day after the date the request was made.
- 12 SECTION 3. Section 418.1181, Government Code, is amended as
- 13 follows:
- 14 Sec. 418.1181. REIMBURSEMENT OF COSTS: REQUEST BY LOCAL
- 15 GOVERNMENT ENTITY. (a) If a local government entity requests
- 16 mutual aid assistance from another local government entity under
- 17 the system, and such assistance requires a response exceeding 12
- 18 <u>consecutive hours</u>, the requesting local government entity shall
- 19 reimburse the actual costs of providing mutual aid assistance to
- 20 the responding local government entity, including costs for
- 21 personnel, operation and maintenance of equipment, damaged
- 22 equipment, food, lodging, and transportation, incurred by the
- 23 responding local government entity in response to a request for
- 24 reimbursement. Local government entities with a mutual aid

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- 1 agreement when the request for mutual aid assistance is made are
- 2 subject to the agreement's terms of reimbursement, as provided by
- 3 Section 418.111.
- 4 SECTION 4. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 5 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 6 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 7 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 8 Act takes effect September 1, 2013.
