- 2 relating to the licensing of minors to operate a motor vehicle.
- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 4 SECTION 1. Section 521.295(a), Transportation Code, is
- 5 re-enacted to read as follows:
- 6 (a) If the department suspends a person's license under
- 7 Section 521.292 or revokes a person's license under Section 521.294
- 8 or 521.2965, the department shall send a notice of suspension or
- 9 revocation by first class mail to the person's address in the
- 10 records of the department.
- 11 SECTION 2. Section 521.296, Transportation Code, is amended
- 12 to read as follows:
- 13 Sec. 521.296. NOTICE OF SUSPENSION OR REVOCATION. A notice
- 14 of suspension under Section 521.292 or revocation under Section
- 15 521.294 or 521.2965 must state:
- 16 (1) the reason and statutory grounds for the suspension or
- 17 revocation;
- 18 (2) the effective date of the suspension or revocation;
- 19 (3) the right of the person to a hearing;
- 20 (4) how to request a hearing; and
- 21 (5) the period in which the person must request a hearing.
- SECTION 3. Subchapter N, Chapter 521, Transportation Code,
- 23 is amended to read as follows:
- Sec. 521.2965. REVOCATION: PERSON UNDER 18 YEARS OF AGE.

- 1 (a) Unless the person complies with the requirements of Subsection
- 2 (b), the department shall revoke the license of a person under 18
- 3 years of age who is enrolled at a public school, home school, or
- 4 private school if a school administrator or law enforcement officer
- 5 notifies the department that the person has been absent from school
- 6 for at least 20 consecutive instructional days.
- 7 (b) The department shall notify the person in writing of a
- 8 truancy report made against the person under Subsection (a). The
- 9 revocation of a license by the department under this section
- 10 becomes effective on the 30th day after the date of the notice,
- 11 unless before that date the person provides to the department
- 12 information required by the department to demonstrate the person's
- 13 school attendance.
- 14 (c) The notice provided to a person under Subsection (b)
- 15 <u>must:</u>
- 16 <u>(1) state that the revocation becomes effective on the 30th</u>
- 17 day after the date of the notice; and
- 18 (2) contain information regarding the procedures and
- 19 documentation that the person may provide to the department in
- 20 order to avoid the revocation of the person's license.
- 21 SECTION 4. This Act takes effect September 1, 2013.
