11	ammunition manufacturers interested in expanding or relocating to
12	the state;
13	(c) issue requests for proposals for the location,
14	relocation or expansion of firearm and ammunition manufacturers to

16	(d) upon receipt of proposals, the office shall negotiate or

- 21 SECTION 2. EFFECTIVE DATE. This Act takes effect
