15	<u>HEARINGS</u> . (a) To the extent of a conflict between this chapter and
16	Chapter 2001, Government Code, this chapter controls.
17	(b) A board rule relating to the procedures for a hearing on
18	or the resolution of a dispute arising under this chapter applies to
19	the person conducting the hearing or dispute resolution proceeding,
20	regardless of whether that person is the board, the department, or
21	another person.
22	SECTION 3. The changes in law made by this Act apply to a
23	license issued under Chapter 2301, Occupations Code, regardless of
