4	SECTION 1. Section 419.909, Government Code, is amended to
5	read as follows:
6	Sec. 419.909. FIRE SAFETY INSPECTIONS. (a) Only an
7	individual certified by the commission as a fire inspector may
8	conduct a <u>A</u> fire safety inspection required by a state or local law,
9	rule, regulation, or ordinance. may be conducted by an individual
10	certified by:
11	(1) the Texas Commission on Fire Protection,
12	(2) the State Firemen's and Fire Marshals'
13	Association,
14	(3) the National Fire Protection Association,
15	(4) the International Code Council, or
16	(5) any other state agency with authority over fire
17	safety inspections.
18	(b) A fire safety inspection required by a state or local
19	law, rule, regulation, or ordinance must be conducted in accordance
20	with:
21	(1) the most recent local fire code; or
22	(2) the most recent fire code adopted by the state fire
23	marshal.
24	(c) This section does not apply to state agency personnel

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1 who conduct a life safety code survey of a building or facility in 2 connection with determining whether to issue or renew a license 3 under Chapter 142, 241, 242, 243, 244, 245, 247, 248, 251, 252, 464, 4 66, 577, Health and Safety Code, or Chapter 103, Human Resources 5 Code.

6 SECTION 2. EFFECTIVE DATE. This Act takes effect 7 immediately if it receives a vote of two-thirds of all the members 8 elected to each house, as provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas 9 Constitution. If this Act does not receive the vote necessary for 10 immediate effect, this Act takes effect September 1, 2013.
