- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 4 SECTION 1. Subtitle C, Title 5, Business & Commerce Code, is
- 5 amended by adding Chapter 110 to read as follows:

6 CHAPTER 110. ROOFING CONTRACTORS

- 7 Sec. 110.001. DEFINITION. In this chapter, "roofing
- 8 contractor" means a person who, for compensation, provides a
- 9 roofing service, including the installation, construction,
- 10 maintenance, service, repair, alteration, or modification of any
- 11 part of a roof.
- 12 Sec. 110.002. PROHIBITED CONDUCT. A roofing contractor may
- 13 not:
- 14 (1) assist a customer to obtain payment under an
- 15 insurance policy for a roofing service or product provided by the
- 16 contractor, without regard to whether the contractor is compensated
- 17 for providing the assistance; or
- 18 (2) bear the cost, directly or indirectly, of an
- 19 insurance policy deductible applicable to a roofing service or
- 20 product provided by the contractor.
- Sec. 110.003. PROHIBITED AGREEMENT. A roofing contractor
- 22 may not enter into an agreement with a customer or potential
- 23 <u>customer under which the contractor agrees to engage in conduct</u>
- 24 prohibited by Section 110.002.

- 1 Sec. 110.004. REQUIRED DISCLOSURE OF LIABILITY INSURANCE
- 2 COVERAGE. Before or at the time of entering into a contract for a
- 3 roofing service, a roofing contractor must disclose in writing to
- 4 the customer or potential customer whether the contractor is
- 5 covered by a liability insurance policy that covers the contractor
- 6 for liability for damages arising out of the provision of roofing
- 7 services. At the request of the customer or potential customer, the
- 8 roofing contractor shall provide to the customer or potential
- 9 customer a copy of the declarations page of any applicable
- 10 liability insurance policy.
- Sec. 110.005. INSURANCE ADJUSTERS. An insurance adjuster
- 12 licensed under Chapter 4101, Insurance Code, or a public insurance
- 13 <u>adjuster licensed under Chapter 4102</u>, Insurance Code, may not
- 14 engage in business as a roofing contractor.
- Sec. 110.006. OFFENSE. A person commits an offense if the
- 16 person is a roofing contractor and violates this chapter. An
- 17 offense under this section is a Class C misdemeanor.
- SECTION 2. Chapter 4101, Insurance Code, is amended by
- 19 adding Subchapter F to read as follows:
- 20 SUBCHAPTER F. PROHIBITED CONDUCT
- Sec. 4101.251. CERTAIN ROOFING-RELATED BUSINESS
- 22 PROHIBITED. A licensed adjuster may not engage in business as a
- 23 roofing contractor, as that term is defined by Section 110.001,
- 24 Business & Commerce Code.
- 25 SECTION 3. Subchapter D, Chapter 4102, Insurance Code, is
- 26 amended by adding Section 4102.163 to read as follows:
- Sec. 4102.163. CERTAIN ROOFING-RELATED BUSINESS

- 1 PROHIBITED. A license holder may not engage in business as a
- 2 roofing contractor, as that term is defined by Section 110.001,
- 3 Business & Commerce Code.
- 4 SECTION 4. This Act takes effect September 1, 2013.
