2	relating to pharmacy benefit managers contracting with the child
3	health plan program, the Medicaid managed care program, and health
4	plans for certain government employees.
5	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
6	SECTION 1. Chapter 531, Government Code, is amended by
7	adding Subchapter Y to read as follows:
8	SUBCHAPTER Y. PHARMACY BENEFIT MANAGERS
9	Sec. 531.990. APPLICABILITY. This subchapter applies only
10	to a Medicaid managed care program under Chapter 533 and the child
11	health plan program.
12	Sec. 531.991. TRANSPARENCY IN PHARMACY BENEFIT MANAGEMENT.
13	(a) In this section, "maximum allowable cost" means a maximum
14	reimbursement amount for a group of therapeutically and
15	pharmaceutically equivalent multiple source medications.
16	(b) A contract to provide pharmacy benefit manager services
17	must require the pharmacy benefit manager to:
18	(1) establish:
19	(A) a method of calculating, updating, and
20	revising a maximum allowable cost for each covered medication;
21	(B) a frequency for updating or revising the
22	<pre>maximum allowable cost; and</pre>
23	(C) a maximum allowable cost list that uniformly

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serves as a basis for the calculation of reimbursement amounts for

- 1 pharmacy claims covered by the child health plan program or
- 2 Medicaid managed care program; and
- 3 (2) develop and maintain a public Internet website and
- 4 post and maintain on the website the information required by
- 5 Subdivision (1).
- 6 (c) A contract to provide pharmacy benefit manager services
- 7 must require the pharmacy benefit manager to provide to the
- 8 commission the information required by Subsection (b)(1). On
- 9 request, the commission shall provide the information to a
- 10 pharmacist or pharmacy.
- 11 SECTION 2. Subchapter B, Chapter 1551, Insurance Code, is
- 12 amended by adding Section 1551.0671 to read as follows:
- Sec. 1551.0671. TRANSPARENCY IN PHARMACY BENEFIT
- 14 MANAGEMENT. (a) In this section, "maximum allowable cost" means a
- 15 maximum reimbursement amount for a group of therapeutically and

- 17 (b) A contract to provide pharmacy benefit manager services

- 27 (2) develop and maintain a public Internet website and

- 3 (c) A contract to provide pharmacy benefit manager services
- 4 must require the pharmacy benefit manager to provide to the board of
- 5 trustees the information required by Subsection (b)(1). On
- 6 request, the board of trustees shall provide the information to a
- 7 pharmacist or pharmacy.
- 8 SECTION 3. Subchapter C, Chapter 1575, Insurance Code, is
- 9 amended by adding Section 1575.111 to read as follows:
- 10 Sec. 1575.111. TRANSPARENCY IN PHARMACY BENEFIT
- 11 MANAGEMENT. (a) In this section, "maximum allowable cost" means a
- 12 maximum reimbursement amount for a group of therapeutically and
- 13 pharmaceutically equivalent multiple source medications.
- 14 (b) A contract to provide pharmacy benefit manager services
- 15 must require the pharmacy benefit manager to:
- 16 (1) establish:
- 17 (A) a method of calculating, updating, and
- 18 revising a maximum allowable cost for each covered medication;
- 19 (B) a frequency for updating or revising a
- 20 maximum allowable cost; and
- (C) a maximum allowable cost list that uniformly

- 23 pharmacy claims covered by the group program; and
- 24 (2) develop and maintain a public Internet website and
- 25 post and maintain on the website the information required by

- 27 (c) A contract to provide pharmacy benefit manager services

- 1 must require the pharmacy benefit manager to provide to the trustee
- 2 the information required by Subsection (b)(1). On request, the
- 3 trustee shall provide the information to a pharmacist or pharmacy.
- 4 SECTION 4. Subchapter B, Chapter 1579, Insurance Code, is
- 5 amended by adding Section 1579.058 to read as follows:
- 6 Sec. 1579.058. TRANSPARENCY IN PHARMACY BENEFIT
- 7 MANAGEMENT. (a) In this section, "maximum allowable cost" means a
- 8 maximum reimbursement amount for a group of therapeutically and
- 9 pharmaceutically equivalent multiple source medications.
- 10 (b) A contract to provide pharmacy benefit manager services
- 11 must require the pharmacy benefit manager to:
- 12 (1) establish:
- (A) a method of calculating, updating, and
- 14 revising a maximum allowable cost for each covered medication;
- 15 (B) a frequency for updating or revising a
- 16 <u>maximum allowable cost; and</u>
- 17 (C) a maximum allowable cost list that uniformly
- 18 serves as a basis for the calculation of reimbursement amounts for
- 19 pharmacy claims covered by a health coverage plan; and
- 20 (2) develop and maintain a public Internet website and
- 21 post and maintain on the website the information required by
- 22 <u>Subdivision (1).</u>
- 23 <u>(c) A contract to provide pharmacy benefit manager services</u>
- 24 must require the pharmacy benefit manager to provide to the trustee
- 25 the information required by Subsection (b)(1). On request, the
- 26 trustee shall provide the information to a pharmacist or pharmacy.
- 27 SECTION 5. Subchapter B, Chapter 1601, Insurance Code, is

- 1 amended by adding Section 1601.065 to read as follows:
- 2 Sec. 1601.065. TRANSPARENCY IN PHARMACY BENEFIT
- 3 MANAGEMENT. (a) In this section, "maximum allowable cost" means a
- 4 maximum reimbursement amount for a group of therapeutically and
- 5 pharmaceutically equivalent multiple source medications.
- 6 (b) A contract to provide pharmacy benefit manager services
- 7 must require the pharmacy benefit manager to:
- 8 <u>(1) establish:</u>
- 9 (A) a method of calculating, updating, and
- 10 revising the maximum allowable cost for each covered medication;
- 11 (B) a frequency for updating or revising a
- 12 maximum allowable cost; and
- (C) a maximum allowable cost list that uniformly
- 14 serves as a basis for the calculation of reimbursement amounts for
- 15 pharmacy claims covered by the basic coverage; and
- 16 (2) develop and maintain a public Internet website and
- 17 post and maintain on the website the information required by
- 18 Subdivision (1).
- 19 <u>(c)</u> A contract to provide pharmacy benefit manager services
- 20 must require the pharmacy benefit manager to provide to the
- 21 governing board of the system the information required by
- 22 <u>Subsection (b)(1).</u> On request, the system shall provide the
- 23 information to a pharmacist or pharmacy.
- SECTION 6. Subchapter Y, Chapter 531, Government Code, and
- 25 Sections 1551.0671, 1575.111, 1579.058, and 1601.065, Insurance
- 26 Code, as added by this Act, apply only to a contract with a pharmacy
- 27 benefit manager executed or renewed on or after the effective date

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- 1 of this Act.
- 2 SECTION 7. This Act takes effect September 1, 2013.
