8	(1) Cymodocea filiformis, known as manatee grass;
9	(2) Halodule beaudettei or Halodule wrightii, known as
10	shoal grass;
11	(3) Halophila engelmannii, known as star grass or
12	<pre>Engelmann's seagrass;</pre>
13	(4) Ruppia maritima, known as widgeon grass; or
14	(5) Thalassia testudinum, known as turtle grass.
15	(b) A person may not uproot or dig out any rooted seagrass
16	plant from a bay bottom or other saltwater bottom area in the
17	jurisdiction of this state by means of a propeller, except as that
18	uprooting or digging out may be authorized by a commercial license
19	or permit issued by the department.
20	(c) It is a defense to prosecution under this section that a
21	person:
22	(1) anchors a vessel within an area containing
23	seagrass plants and uproots a seagrass plant;
24	(2) uses an electric trolling motor within an area

- 1 containing seagrass plants and uproots a seagrass plant; or
- 2 (3) operates a vessel in a manner consistent with the
- 3 <u>acceleration required to reach and stay on plane.</u>
- 4 (d) A person who violates this section or a proclamation of
- 5 the commission under this section commits an offense that is a Class
- 6 <u>C Parks and Wildlife Code misdemeanor.</u>
- 7 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2013.
