1 with a population under 100,000 on receipt of a written request for 2 those hours submitted by at least 15 registered voters of the 3 county. The request must be submitted in time to enable compliance 4 with Section 85.007. This subsection supersedes any provision of 5 this subchapter to the extent of any conflict.

6 SECTION 3. The changes in law made by this Act apply only to 7 an election for which early voting begins on or after September 1, 8 2013.
