- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Subchapter B, Chapter 55, Education Code, is
- 6 amended by adding Section 55.17861 to read as follows:
- 7 Sec. 55.17861. TEXAS WOMAN'S UNIVERSITY; ADDITIONAL BONDS.
- 8 (a) In addition to the other authority granted under this
- 9 subchapter, the board of regents of Texas Woman's University may
- 10 acquire, purchase, construct, improve, renovate, enlarge, or equip
- 11 property and facilities, including roads and related
- 12 infrastructure, for a science and technology learning center at
- 13 Texas Woman's University to be financed by the issuance of bonds in
- 14 accordance with this subchapter, in an aggregate principal amount
- 15 not to exceed \$38 million.

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- 16 (b) The board may pledge irrevocably to the payment of the
- 17 bonds authorized by this section all or any part of the revenue
- 18 <u>funds of Texas Woman's University</u>, including student tuition
- 19 charges. The amount of a pledge made under this subsection may not
- 20 be reduced or abrogated while the bonds for which the pledge is
- 21 made, or bonds issued to refund those bonds, are outstanding.
- 22 SECTION 2. Section 61.0572(e), Education Code, is amended
- 23 to read as follows:
- (e) Approval of the board is not required to acquire real

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- 1 property that is financed by bonds issued under Section 55.17(e)(3)
- 2 or (4), 55.1713-55.1718, 55.1721-55.1728, 55.1735(a)(1), 55.174,
- 3 55.1742, 55.1743, 55.1744, 55.1751-55.17592, 55.1768, 55.1771,
- 4 $[\frac{or}{s}]$ 55.17721, or 55.17861, except that the board shall review all
- 5 real property to be financed by bonds issued under those sections to
- 6 determine whether the property meets the standards adopted by the
- 7 board for cost, efficiency, and space use. If the property does not
- 8 meet those standards, the board shall notify the governor, the
- 9 lieutenant governor, the speaker of the house of representatives,
- 10 and the Legislative Budget Board.
- SECTION 3. Section 61.058(b), Education Code, is amended to
- 12 read as follows:
- 13 (b) This section does not apply to construction, repair, or
- 14 rehabilitation financed by bonds issued under Section 55.17(e)(3)
- 15 or (4), 55.1713-55.1718, 55.1721-55.1728, 55.174, 55.1742,
- 16 55.1743, 55.1744, 55.1751-55.17592, 55.1768, 55.1771, [ox]
- 17 55.17721, or 55.17861, except that the board shall review all
- 18 construction, repair, or rehabilitation to be financed by bonds
- 19 issued under those sections to determine whether the construction,
- 20 rehabilitation, or repair meets the standards adopted by board rule
- 21 for cost, efficiency, and space use. If the construction,
- 22 rehabilitation, or repair does not meet those standards, the board
- 23 shall notify the governor, the lieutenant governor, the speaker of
- 24 the house of representatives, and the Legislative Budget Board.
- 25 SECTION 4. This Act does not affect any authority or
- 26 restriction regarding the activities that a public institution of
- 27 higher education may conduct in connection with a facility financed

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- 1 by bonds authorized by this Act.
- 2 SECTION 5. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 3 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 4 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 5 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 6 Act takes effect September 1, 2013.
