- 4 SECTION 1. Section 201.002(b), Occupations Code, is amended
- 5 to read as follows:
- 6 (b) A person practices chiropractic under this chapter if
- 7 the person:
- 8 (1) uses objective or subjective means to analyze,
- 9 examine, [or] evaluate, or diagnose the biomechanical condition of
- 10 the spine and musculoskeletal system of the human body;
- 11 (2) performs nonsurgical, nonincisive procedures,
- 12 including adjustment and manipulation, to improve the subluxation
- 13 complex or the biomechanics of the musculoskeletal system;
- 14 (3) in the course of practicing as provided by
- 15 Subdivisions (1) and (2), identifies and provisionally diagnoses a
- 16 disease or condition for which treatment by the practice of
- 17 chiropractic is contraindicated and for the purpose of referring a
- 18 patient to another health care practitioner;
- 19 $\underline{(4)}$ represents to the public that the person is a
- 20 chiropractor; or
- (5) $\left[\frac{(4)}{(4)}\right]$ uses the term "chiropractor,"
- 22 "chiropractic," "doctor of chiropractic," "D.C.," or any
- 23 derivative of those terms or initials in connection with the
- 24 person's name.

- 1 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 2 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 3 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 4 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 5 Act takes effect September 1, 2013.
