4	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
5	SECTION 1. Section 39.023, Education Code, is amended by
6	adding Subsection (b-1) to read as follows:
7	(b-1) A teacher may not be required to prepare assessment
8	tasks and materials for a student who will be administered a state
9	mandated alternative assessment instrument developed or adopted
10	under Subsection (b). Teachers will provide presentation supports.
11	SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
12	a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
13	provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this

14 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this

15 Act takes effect September 1, 2013.
