| 14 | high school student is entitled to pay tuition and fees for the |
| 15 | course at the rates provided for residents of this state if the |
| 16 | student satisfies the requirements of Section 54.052(a)(1). The |
| 17 | institution shall determine whether the student is entitled to pay |
| 18 | tuition and fees at resident rates under this section without |
| 19 | reference to whether the student is a dependent for purposes of |

beginning with tuition and fees charged for the 2013 fall semester.
Tuition and fees charged for a term or semester before the 2013 fall
semester are covered by the law in effect immediately before the
effective date of this Act, and the former law is continued in
effect for that purpose.

6 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives 7 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as 8 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this 9 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this 10 Act takes effect September 1, 2013.
