A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

2	relating to certain comprehensive development agreements of the
3	Texas Department of Transportation.
4	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
5	SECTION 1. Sections $223.201(f)$, (i) , and (j) ,
6	Transportation Code, are amended to read as follows:
7	(f) The department may enter into a comprehensive
8	development agreement only for all or part of:
9	(1) the State Highway 99 (Grand Parkway) project;
10	(2) the Interstate Highway 35E managed lanes project
11	in Dallas and Denton Counties from Interstate Highway 635 to U.S.
12	Highway 380;
13	(3) the North Tarrant Express project in Tarrant and
14	Dallas Counties, including:
15	(A) [on State Highway 183 from State Highway 121
16	to Statc Highway 161 (Segment 2E);
17	[(B)] on Interstate Highway 35W from Interstate
18	Highway 30 to State Highway 114 (Segments 3A, 3B, and 3C); and
19	(B) [(C)] on Interstate Highway 820 from State
20	Highway 183 North to south of Randol Mill Road (Segment 4);
21	(4) the State Highway 183 managed lanes project in
22	Dallas <u>and Tarrant Counties</u> [County] from State Highway <u>121</u> [161]
23	to Interstate Highway 35E <u>, including:</u>

(A) State Highway 114 from State Highway 183 to

1 International Parkway; and

- 2 (B) Loop 12 from State Highway 183 to Interstate
- 3 Highway 35E.
- 4 (5) the State Highway 249 project in Harris and
- 5 Montgomery Counties from Spring Cypress Road to Farm-to-Market Road
- 6 1774;
- 7 (6) the State Highway 288 project in Brazoria County
- 8 and Harris County; and
- 9 (7) the U.S. Highway 290 Hempstead managed lanes
- 10 project in Harris County from Interstate Highway 610 to State
- 11 Highway 99.
- 12 (i) The authority to enter into a comprehensive development
- 13 agreement for a project described by Subsection (f), other than the
- 14 State Highway 99 (Grand Parkway) project expires August 31, 2015.
- 15 (j) Before the department may enter into a comprehensive
- 16 development agreement under Subsection (f), the department must:
- 17 (1) obtain, not later than August 31, 2013, the
- 18 appropriate environmental clearance for any project other than the
- 19 State Highway 99 (Grand Parkway) project; and
- 20 (2) present to the commission a full financial plan
- 21 for the project, including costing methodology and cost proposals.
- 22 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 23 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 24 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 25 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 26 Act takes effect September 1, 2013.
