- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Section 533.006, Government Code, is amended by 6 adding Subsection (c) to read as follows:
- 7 <u>(c) The commission shall require that each managed care</u> 8 organization that contracts with the commission to provide health
- 9 care services to recipients in a region allow a supplier of durable
- 10 medical equipment and other supplies used specifically for enteral
- 11 <u>nutrition therapy to participate as a provider in the managed care</u>
- 12 <u>organization's provider network if the supplier:</u>
- 13 (1) agrees to comply with the financial terms and
- 14 conditions of the managed care organization's provider contract as
- 15 well as other reasonable administrative and professional terms of
- 16 that contract; and

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- 17 (2) is not prohibited from participating as a Medicaid
- 18 provider by Section 32.047, Human Resources Code, or any other
- 19 provision excluding the provider based on conduct that constitutes
- 20 <u>fraud, waste, or abuse.</u>
- 21 SECTION 2. The Health and Human Services Commission shall,
- 22 in a contract between the commission and a managed care
- 23 organization under Chapter 533, Government Code, that is entered
- 24 into or renewed on or after the effective date of this Act, require

- 1 that the managed care organization comply with Section 533.006(c),
- 2 Government Code, as amended by this Act.
- 3 SECTION 3. If before implementing any provision of this Act
- 4 a state agency determines that a waiver or authorization from a
- 5 federal agency is necessary for implementation of that provision,
- 6 the agency affected by the provision shall request the waiver or
- 7 authorization and may delay implementing that provision until the
- 8 waiver or authorization is granted.
- 9 SECTION 4. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 10 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 11 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 12 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 13 Act takes effect September 1, 2013.
