22	(c) Not later than January 1, 2015, the commission shall
23	report to the legislature on the use of nutrition and wellness

1 report must include:

2 (1) feedback from clients on the effectiveness of the 3 information accessed; and

4 (2) any available data on the number of individuals
5 who accessed the information.

6 (d) The executive commissioner may adopt rules to implement
7 this section.

(e) This section expires September 1, 2015.

9 SECTION 2. If before implementing any provision of this Act 10 a state agency determines that a waiver or authorization from a 11 federal agency is necessary for implementation of that provision, 12 the agency affected by the provision shall request the waiver or 13 authorization and may delay implementing that provision until the 14 waiver or authorization is granted.

SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2013.
