4	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
5	SECTION 1. Section 773.003, Health and Safety Code, is
6	amended by adding Subdivision (18-a) to read as follows:
7	(18-a) "Nighttime triage equipment" means a
8	multicolored illuminated tag with blue, green, red, and yellow
9	lights that is reusable, water resistant to 30 feet, and able to
10	provide a flashing and a solid light.
11	SECTION 2. Section 773.112(c), Health and Safety Code, is
12	amended to read as follows:
13	(c) The rules must include:
14	(1) prehospital care management guidelines for triage
15	and transportation of trauma patients;
16	(2) flow patterns of trauma patients and geographic
17	boundaries regarding trauma patients;
18	(3) assurances that trauma facilities will provide
19	quality care to trauma patients referred to the facilities;
20	(4) minimum requirements for resources and equipment
21	needed by a trauma facility to treat trauma patients;
22	(5) standards for the availability and qualifications
23	of the health care personnel, including physicians and surgeons,
24	treating trauma patients within a facility;

No. 3430 1 (6) requirements for data collection, including trauma incidence reporting, system operation, and patient outcome; 2 3 (7) requirements for periodic performance evaluation of the system and its components; [and] 4 5 (8) assurances that designated trauma facilities will not refuse to accept the transfer of a trauma patient from another 6 facility solely because of the person's inability to pay for 7 8 services or because of the person's age, sex, race, religion, or national origin; and 9 (9) minimum requirements for resources and equipment 10 used by emergency medical services personnel to treat patients at 11 12 night and during adverse conditions using nighttime triage 13 equipment. SECTION 3. Section 773.114(a), Health and Safety Code, is 14 15 amended to read as follows: 16 (a) Each emergency medical services and trauma care system 17 must have: (1)local or regional medical control for all field 18 19 care and transportation, consistent with geographic and current communications capability; 20 21 (2) triage, transport, and transfer protocols, including protocols for the use of nighttime triage equipment at 22 23 night and during adverse conditions; and 24 (3) one or more hospitals categorized according to trauma care capabilities using standards adopted by board rule. 25 26 SECTION 4. (a) The executive commissioner of the Health and Human Services Commission shall adopt rules necessary to 27

this Act, not later than December 1, 2013.

3 (b) An emergency medical services and trauma care system is 4 not required to have the nighttime triage equipment protocols 5 required under Section 773.114(a)(2), Health and Safety Code, as 6 amended by this Act, until January 1, 2014.

7 SECTION 5. This Act takes effect September 1, 2013.

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
