1-25 relating to the eligibility of a person to serve on the appraisal  
 1-26 review board of an appraisal district.

1-27 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

1-28 SECTION 1. Section 6.412(d), Tax Code, is amended to read as  
 1-29 follows:

1-30 (d) A person is ineligible to serve on the appraisal review  
 1-31 board of an appraisal district established for a county having a  
 1-32 population of more than 100,000:

1-33 (1) if the person:

1-34 (A) has served for all or part of three previous  
 1-35 terms as a board member or auxiliary board member on the appraisal  
 1-36 review board; or

1-37 (B) is a former member of the board of directors,  
 1-38 officer, or employee of the appraisal district; ~~or~~

1-39 (2) if the person served as a member of the governing  
 1-40 body or officer of a taxing unit for which the appraisal district  
 1-41 appraises property, until the fourth anniversary of the date the  
 1-42 person ceased to be a member or officer; or

1-43 (3) if the person ~~has ever~~ appeared before the  
 1-44 appraisal review board for compensation during the two-year period  
 1-45 preceding the date the person is appointed.

1-46 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2013.

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
