A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT

2 relating to the obligation of an appraisal review board to respond 3 to a property owner's request to postpone a hearing of the board.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

5 SECTION 1. Section 41.45(e), Tax Code, is amended to read as 6 follows:

7 (e) On request made to the appraisal review board before the date of the hearing, a property owner who has not designated an 8 9 agent under Section 1.111 to represent the owner at the hearing is entitled to one postponement of the hearing to a later date without 10 11 showing cause. In addition and without limitation as to the number 12 of postponements, the board shall postpone the hearing to a later date if the property owner or the owner's agent at any time shows 13 14 good cause for the postponement or if the chief appraiser consents to the postponement. The hearing may not be postponed to a date 15 less than five or more than 30 days after the date scheduled for the 16 hearing when the postponement is sought unless the date and time of 17 the hearing as postponed are agreed to by the chairman of the 18 [appraisal review] board or the chairman's representative, the 19 property owner, and the chief appraiser. A request by a property 20 21 owner for a postponement under this subsection may be made in writing, including by facsimile transmission or electronic mail, by 22 23 telephone, or in person to the [appraisal review] board, a panel of the board, or the chairman of the board. The chairman or the 24

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1 chairman's representative may take action on a postponement under this subsection without the necessity of action by the full board if 2 3 the hearing for which the postponement is requested is scheduled to occur before the next regular meeting of the board. Not later than 4 5 the seventh day after the date a request for a postponement is received, the [The granting by the appraisal review] board, the 6 7 chairman of the board, or the chairman's representative must 8 respond in writing to the property owner or agent making the request and, if the request is granted, provide notice of the date, time, 9 and place fixed for the hearing [of a postponement under this 10 subsection does not require the delivery of additional written 11 12 notice to the property owner].

13 SECTION 2. The change in law made by this Act applies only 14 to a request for a postponement of an appraisal review board hearing 15 received by an appraisal review board on or after the effective date 16 of this Act. A request for a postponement of an appraisal review 17 board hearing received before the effective date of this Act is 18 governed by the law in effect when the request was received, and the 19 former law is continued in effect for that purpose.

20 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives 21 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as 22 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this 23 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this 24 Act takes effect September 1, 2013.

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
