- person is entitled to intervene in an appeal brought under this 8

- 10 in the appeal if the property that is the subject of the appeal was

- 12 (1) owned the property at any time during the tax year

- at issue and the person filed the protest that resulted in the 15

- is shown on the appraisal roll as the owner of the 17

- 21 (4) acquires ownership of the property during the
- pendency of the appeal and the person obtains an assignment of the 22

- 8 SECTION 2. Section 42.016, Tax Code, as amended by this Act,

- 10 Act or that is filed on or after the effective date of this Act.
- 11 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 12 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 13 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 14 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 15 Act takes effect September 1, 2013.
