## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT

- 2 relating to the authority of a county clerk to require an individual
- 3 to present photo identification to file certain documents.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Chapter 191, Local Government Code, is amended
- 6 by adding Section 191.010 to read as follows:
- 7 Sec. 191.010. AUTHORITY TO REQUIRE PHOTO IDENTIFICATION TO
- 8 FILE CERTAIN DOCUMENTS. (a) In this section, "photo
- 9 identification" means one of the following forms of photo
- 10 identification:

- 11 (1) a driver's license, election identification
- 12 certificate, or personal identification card issued to the person
- 13 by any state or territory of the United States that has not expired
- 14 or that expired no earlier than 60 days before the date of
- 15 presentation;
- 16 (2) a United States military identification card that
- 17 contains the person's photograph that has not expired or that
- 18 expired no earlier than 60 days before the date of presentation;
- 19 (3) a United States citizenship certificate issued to
- 20 the person that contains the person's photograph;
- 21 (4) a United States passport or a passport issued by a
- 22 foreign government recognized by the United States issued to the
- 23 person that has not expired or that expired no earlier than 60 days
- 24 before the date of presentation; or

- 1 (5) a license to carry a concealed handgun issued to
- 2 the person by the Department of Public Safety that has not expired
- 3 or that expired no earlier than 60 days before the date of
- 4 presentation.
- 5 (b) A county clerk may require a person presenting a
- 6 document in person for filing in the real property records of the
- 7 county to present a photo identification to the clerk. The clerk
- 8 may copy the photo identification or record information from the
- 9 photo identification. The clerk may not charge a person a fee to
- 10 copy or record the information from a photo identification.
- 11 (c) Information copied or recorded from the photo
- 12 identification is confidential.
- 13 (d) A document filed with a county clerk is not invalid
- 14 solely because the county clerk did not copy a photo identification
- or record the information from the photo identification.
- SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 17 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 18 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 19 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 20 Act takes effect September 1, 2013.
