- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Section 361.964(b), Health and Safety Code, is
- 6 amended to read as follows:
- 7 (b) For the purposes of recycling, reusing, or otherwise
- 8 disposing of collected computer equipment, a manufacturer must:
- 9 (1) follow the standards established under
- 10 "Responsible Recycling Practices for Use in Accredited
- 11 Certification Programs for Electronic Recyclers" or "e-Stewards
- 12 Standard for Responsible Recycling and Reuse of Electronic
- 13 Equipment" or an equivalent independently audited certification
- 14 standard for electronics recycling; or
- 15 (2) use a recycler that has a current certification
- 16 indicating the recycler complies with the standards described by
- 17 <u>Subdivision (1)</u> [The commission shall adopt as standards for
- 18 recycling or reuse of computer equipment in this state the
- 19 standards provided by "Electronics Recycling Operating Practices"
- 20 as approved by the board of directors of the Institute of Scrap
- 21 Recycling Industries, Inc., April 25, 2006, or other standards from
- 22 a comparable nationally recognized organization].
- SECTION 2. Section 361.982(b), Health and Safety Code, is
- 24 amended to read as follows:

- 1 (b) A person who is engaged in the business of recycling
- 2 covered television equipment in this state shall:
- 3 (1) register with the commission and certify that the
- 4 person is in compliance with the standards described by [adopted
- 5 under] Section 361.990;
- 6 (2) on or before January 31 of each year renew the
- 7 registration with the commission and certify the person's continued
- 8 compliance with the standards described by [adopted under] Section
- 9 361.990;
- 10 (3) recycle all covered television equipment accepted
- 11 for recycling in accordance with the standards adopted under
- 12 Section 361.990;
- 13 (4) maintain a written log recording the weight of all
- 14 covered television equipment received by the person and the
- 15 disposition of that equipment; and
- 16 (5) annually report to the commission the total weight
- 17 of covered television equipment received and recycled by the person
- 18 in the preceding 12 months.
- 19 SECTION 3. Section 361.990(b), Health and Safety Code, is
- 20 amended to read as follows:
- 21 (b) For the purposes of recycling, reusing, or otherwise
- 22 disposing of collected covered television equipment, a
- 23 <u>manufacturer must:</u>
- 24 (1) follow the standards established under
- 25 "Responsible Recycling Practices for Use in Accredited
- 26 <u>Certification Programs for Electronic Recyclers" or "e-Stewards</u>
- 27 Standard for Responsible Recycling and Reuse of Electronic

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- 1 Equipment" or an equivalent independently audited certification
- 2 standard for electronics recycling; or
- 3 (2) use a recycler that has a current certification
- 4 indicating the recycler complies with the standards described by
- 5 Subdivision (1) [The commission shall adopt as standards for
- 6 recycling or reuse of covered television equipment in this state
- 7 the standards provided by "Electronics Recycling Operating
- 8 Practices" as approved by the board of directors of the Institute of
- 9 Scrap Recycling Industries, Incorporated, April 25, 2006, or other
- 10 standards from a comparable nationally recognized organization].
- 11 SECTION 4. This Act takes effect September 1, 2013.
