A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT

- 2 relating to educator financial incentives and salary contingencies
- 3 based on student performance on certain assessment instruments.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Subchapter I, Chapter 21, Education Code, is
- 6 amended by adding Section 21.418 to read as follows:
- 7 Sec. 21.418. CERTAIN INCENTIVES AND SALARY CONTINGENCIES
- 8 PROHIBITED. (a) Subject to Subsection (b), a school district may
- 9 not:
- 10 (1) offer or reward a financial incentive to an
- 11 educator that is contingent on student performance on an assessment
- 12 <u>instrument administered under Chapter 39; or</u>
- 13 (2) make any portion of an educator's salary
- 14 contingent on student performance on an assessment instrument
- 15 administered under Chapter 39.
- 16 (b) This section does not affect the use of any federal
- 17 funds disbursed for a purpose otherwise prohibited under Subsection
- 18 <u>(a).</u>
- 19 SECTION 2. Section 21.702(b), Education Code, is amended to
- 20 read as follows:
- 21 (b) In establishing the program, the commissioner shall
- 22 adopt program guidelines in accordance with this subchapter for a
- 23 school district to follow in developing a local awards plan under
- 24 Section 21.704. The guidelines must prohibit a school district

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- 1 from making awards on the basis of student performance on an
- 2 assessment instrument administered under Chapter 39, as prohibited
- 3 <u>under Section 21.418.</u>
- 4 SECTION 3. This Act applies beginning with the 2013-2014
- 5 school year.
- 6 SECTION 4. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- $7\,$ a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 8 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 9 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 10 Act takes effect September 1, 2013.
