- 2 relating to the extent of extraterritorial jurisdiction of certain

- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Section 42.021(a), Local Government Code, is
- 6 amended to read as follows:
- 7 (a) The extraterritorial jurisdiction of a municipality is
- 8 the unincorporated area that is contiguous to the corporate
- 9 boundaries of the municipality and that is located:
- 10 (1) within one-half mile of those boundaries, in the
- 11 case of a municipality with fewer than 3,500 [5,000] inhabitants;
- 12 (2) within one mile of those boundaries, in the case of
- 13 a municipality with 3,500 [5,000] to 24,999 inhabitants;
- 14 (3) within two miles of those boundaries, in the case
- of a municipality with 25,000 to 49,999 inhabitants;
- 16 (4) within 3-1/2 miles of those boundaries, in the
- 17 case of a municipality with 50,000 to 99,999 inhabitants; or
- 18 (5) within five miles of those boundaries, in the case
- 19 of a municipality with 100,000 or more inhabitants.
- 20 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 21 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 22 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 23 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 24 Act takes effect September 1, 2013.
