- 1 behalf of any school in the district and the amount of revenue per
- 2 student that is expended to pay for special education programs
- 3 administered in the district in accordance with Chapter 29. Such a
- 4 <u>district must take an action or combination of actions listed under</u>
- 5 subsection (a) only if and to the extent that the new net wealth
- 6 <u>level per student, as calculated in accordance with this</u>
- 7 subsection, exceeds the equalized wealth level calculated in
- 8 Section 41.002.
