- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Section 775.034(h), Health and Safety Code, is
- 6 amended to read as follows:
- 7 (h) This section does not apply to a district located wholly
- 8 in a county:
- 9 (1) with a population of more than three million; or
- 10 (2) that borders another state and the Gulf
- 11 Intracoastal Waterway.
- 12 SECTION 2. The heading to Section 775.0345, Health and
- 13 Safety Code, is amended to read as follows:
- 14 Sec. 775.0345. ELECTION OF BOARD IN CERTAIN [POPULOUS]
- 15 COUNTIES.
- SECTION 3. Section 775.0345(a), Health and Safety Code, is
- 17 amended to read as follows:
- 18 (a) This section applies only to a district located wholly
- 19 in a county:
- 20 <u>(1)</u> with a population of more than three million; or
- 21 (2) that borders another state and the Gulf
- 22 Intracoastal Waterway.
- SECTION 4. The heading to Section 775.0445, Health and
- 24 Safety Code, is amended to read as follows:

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- 1 Sec. 775.0445. VACANCY ON BOARD OF DISTRICT LOCATED IN
- 2 CERTAIN [POPULOUS] COUNTIES.
- 3 SECTION 5. Section 775.0445(b), Health and Safety Code, is
- 4 amended to read as follows:
- 5 (b) This section applies only to a district located wholly
- 6 in a county:
- 7 (1) with a population of more than three million; or
- 8 (2) that borders another state and the Gulf
- 9 Intracoastal Waterway.
- 10 SECTION 6. (a) The changes in law made by this Act do not
- 11 affect the entitlement of a commissioner of a board of emergency
- 12 services commissioners serving on the board immediately before the
- 13 effective date of this Act to continue to carry out the board's
- 14 functions for the remainder of the commissioner's term.
- 15 (b) This Act does not prohibit a person who is a
- 16 commissioner on the effective date of this Act and who was appointed
- 17 under Section 775.034, Health and Safety Code, from running for
- 18 election to the board if the person has the qualifications required
- 19 for a member under Section 775.0345, Health and Safety Code, as
- 20 amended by this Act.
- 21 (c) A person serving as a member of a board of emergency
- 22 services commissioners on the effective date of this Act who was
- 23 appointed under Section 775.034, Health and Safety Code, shall
- 24 continue to serve until the election and qualification of a new
- 25 commissioner for that position.
- 26 (d) In 2014, the county judge of a county with an emergency
- 27 services district to which Section 775.0345(a)(2), Health and

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- 1 Safety Code, as added by this Act, applies and to which Section
- 2 775.034, Health and Safety Code, previously applied, shall
- 3 establish an election as required by Section 775.0345 to replace a
- 4 commissioner appointed before the effective date of this Act as
- 5 near as practicable to the date of the expiration of the appointed
- 6 commissioner's term. A commissioner elected under this subsection
- 7 serves a two-year term but the successor serves a four-year term as
- 8 provided by Section 775.0345, Health and Safety Code.
- 9 (e) In 2015, the county judge shall repeat the procedures
- 10 described by Subsection (d) of this section for the remaining
- 11 appointed commissioners. A commissioner elected under this
- 12 subsection serves a three-year term but the successor serves a
- 13 four-year term as provided by Section 775.0345, Health and Safety
- 14 Code.
- SECTION 7. This Act takes effect September 1, 2013.
