## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

2 relating to long-term statewide planning to achieve the goals of

- 3 the state's master plan for higher education, "Closing the Gaps."
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Subchapter C, Chapter 61, Education Code, is
- 6 amended by adding Section 61.0518 to read as follows:
- 7 Sec. 61.0518. LONG-TERM MASTER PLAN. (a) The board shall
- 8 periodically develop a long-term statewide master plan for higher
- 9 education to assess and make recommendations regarding the state's
- 10 ability to meet the state's goals in providing access to and success
- 11 in higher education to residents of this state. Each plan must
- 12 establish goals and strategies for a period of 15 years.
- 13 (b) The long-term statewide master plan must supplement any
- 14 other master plan established under Section 61.051.
- 15 (c) Notwithstanding Subsection (a), a long-term statewide
- 16 master plan for higher education that is established by the board
- for a period beginning on or after September 1, 2013, must cover the
- 18 period ending September 1, 2036, with reevaluations of goals and
- 19 strategies to occur periodically during the plan's operation. This
- 20 subsection expires December 31, 2036.
- 21 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 22 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 23 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 24 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
