- 6 SECTION 1. Section 501.010, Government Code, is amended by
- 7 adding Subsection (d) to read as follows:
- 8 (d) The uniform visitation policy must require that, if an
- 9 <u>inmate in a warden's facility has provided the warden with the</u>
- 10 <u>e-mail address or telephone number of the inmate's next of kin, the</u>
- 11 warden shall notify the next of kin of any change in the inmate's
- 12 eligibility to receive visitors.
- SECTION 2. Section 507.030(b), Government Code, is amended
- 14 to read as follows:
- 15 (b) The state jail division shall establish a visitation
- 16 policy for persons confined in state jail felony facilities. The
- 17 policy must require that, if a person confined in a state jail
- 18 felony facility has provided the facility's warden with the e-mail
- 19 address or telephone number of the person's next of kin, the warden
- 20 shall notify the next of kin of any change in the person's
- 21 eligibility to receive visitors.
- SECTION 3. Not later than December 1, 2013, the Texas
- 23 Department of Criminal Justice shall make changes to the
- 24 department's policies under Sections 501.010(b) and 507.030(b),

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- 1 Government Code, as necessary to comply with this Act.
- 2 SECTION 4. This Act takes effect September 1, 2013.
