1-15 A BILL TO BE ENTITLED
 1-16 AN ACT

1-17 relating to the release of extraterritorial jurisdiction by certain
 1-18 municipalities.

1-19 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

1-20 SECTION 1. Subchapter B, Chapter 42, Local Government Code,
 1-21 is amended by adding Section 42.0252 to read as follows:

1-22 Sec. 42.0252. RELEASE OF EXTRATERRITORIAL JURISDICTION
 1-23 EXTENDING ACROSS SHIP CHANNEL. (a) A municipality with an
 1-24 extraterritorial jurisdiction of five miles that extends across a
 1-25 ship channel shall release from its extraterritorial jurisdiction
 1-26 any strip of land less than one mile in width that lies entirely
 1-27 between the edge of the ship channel and the municipal boundary of a
 1-28 second municipality whose extraterritorial jurisdiction would
 1-29 include the strip if not for its inclusion in the first
 1-30 municipality's jurisdiction.

1-31 (b) On the release from the extraterritorial jurisdiction
 1-32 of a municipality under Subsection (a), the released area becomes
 1-33 part of the extraterritorial jurisdiction of the second
 1-34 municipality to the extent described by Section 42.021.

1-35 (c) This section does not apply to:

1-36 (1) a municipality with a population of more than
 1-37 300,000 that is located in a county that borders the Gulf of Mexico;
 1-38 or

1-39 (2) a municipality with a population of more than two
 1-40 million.

1-41 (d) This section does not affect the rights of a navigation
 1-42 district located in the extraterritorial jurisdiction of a
 1-43 municipality described by Subsection (a).

1-44 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2013.
