A political party that makes nominations in this state shall adopt rules that: 8 9 (1) prescribe the parliamentary procedure governing the conduct of party meetings and conventions from the precinct 10 level to the state level, including: 11 12 (A) quorums; 13 casting and counting votes; (B) 14 (C) operation of executive committees; and duties of convention 15 (D) appointment 16 committees; and presentation of matters before a convention; 17 (E) 18 prescribe the method of selecting the party's (2) presidential elector candidates; 19 20 (3) prescribe the manner of selecting party officers, convention delegates, any convention alternates, and convention 21 officials; 22 23 (4) provide for representative apportionment of party 24 officers, convention delegates, any convention alternates, and

1 convention officials throughout the state on the basis of 2 population, party strength, or both, within the appropriate 3 territorial unit;

4 (5) provide for periodic publication and publicizing 5 of party rules; and

6 (6) prescribe the manner of adopting party rules and 7 amendments to the rules.

8 SECTION 2. Section 181.061(a), Election Code, is amended to 9 read as follows:

(a) A political party nominating by convention must make its
nominations for statewide offices at a state convention held on the
<u>first</u> [second] Saturday <u>after the fourth Tuesday</u> in <u>April</u> [June] of
the election year. The state convention consists of delegates
selected at the county conventions held under Subsection (c).

15 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives 16 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as 17 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this 18 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this 19 Act takes effect September 1, 2013.
